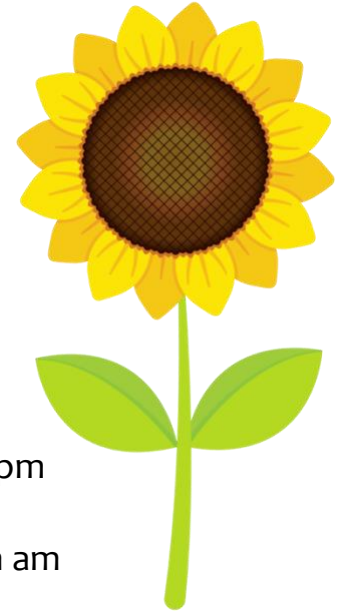


PAC NEWS
